Office of Vital Statistics

The Bureau of Vital Statistics is conducted under the supervision of the Township Registrar. The Registrar's office is required to see that all births, marriages, deaths, and civil unions that take place within the Township of Lyndhurst are properly recorded, filed locally, and with the State of New Jersey Office of Vital Statistics. Certified Copies of vital records, marriage licenses, and burial permits that occurred in Lyndhurst are issued by this office. The Registrar's office is also responsible for all food establishment, and pet licensing.

10:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

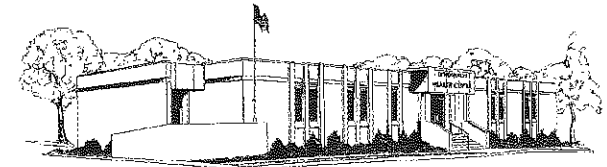
