## 2010 RECYCLING SCHEDULE



All Recyclables must be placed curbside after 6:00 PM the night before your recycling day. Mixed paper (newspapers, magazines, junk mail, cardboard, computer paper, etc.) must be placed in an open container.

Commingled Materials (aluminum, tin, plastic, clear and colored glass bottles) must be placed in an open commingled container.

### GRASS AND BRUSH

Grass clippings only must be placed in an open container on your recycling day. Brush must be cut into four foot sections, tied and bundled, with a four (4) bundle limit.

The grass/brush pick up dates will begin May 3<sup>rd</sup> thru October 29<sup>th</sup>.

No leaves will be accepted during this period of time.



### LEAVES

All leaves are to be placed curbside, before 8:00 AM on your sweeper day. Leaf pick up will be from Monday, November 1<sup>st</sup> thru Thursday, December 24<sup>th</sup>.

Residents with a 3:00 AM - 6:00 AM sweeper time must have leaves placed curbside after 6:00 PM Friday evening.



### CHRISTMAS TREES

Christmas trees will be picked up on your sweeper day in December and January.



Please call 201-438-5478 for pick-ups of white goods (hot water heaters, stoves, washing machines, clothes dryers, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners), electronics, concrete (bricks, blocks, pavers, stones), and tires prior to your recycling day.

THERE WILL BE **NO RECYCLING PICK-UPS** ON THE FOLLOWING DATES:

January 1<sup>st</sup> - New Year's Day • May 31<sup>st</sup> - Memorial Day  
July 4<sup>th</sup> - Independence Day • September 6<sup>th</sup> - Labor Day  
November 25<sup>th</sup> - Thanksgiving Day

THERE WILL BE **NO GARBAGE PICK-UPS** ON THE FOLLOWING DATES:

(Make up day will be the following day)

January 1<sup>st</sup> - New Year's Day • May 31<sup>st</sup> - Memorial Day  
September 6<sup>th</sup> - Labor Day • November 25<sup>th</sup> - Thanksgiving Day • December 25<sup>th</sup> - Christmas Day
