



How to register:

Player and Volunteer Registration takes place on our website www.lyndhurstnjlittleleague.com. If you already have an account, login and click register now. If you do not have an account, please create one. **THE REGISTRATION FEES WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE PLAYER'S LEAGUE AGE.** League Ages 4 to 7 \$85. Ages 8 to 14 \$125.

League Age

Baseball: boys or girls age as of August 31, 2025.

Softball: girls age as of December 31, 2024.

Review the Little League age chart <http://www.littleleague.org/play-little-league/determine-league-age/> to determine your child's "Little League Age" and eligibility.

Important Dates

- Registration opens: November 29, 2024.
- Black Friday Discount Ends: December 2, 2024.
- Registration Late Fee: starts February 1, 2025.
- Registration ends: February 9, 2025
- Player Evaluations: February 7th, 8th, and 9th (times and location TBD).
- Practices begin early March. The team coaches will inform parents.
- Opening Day Parade and Ceremonies and Picture Day: April 5, 2025.
- League Fun Day: May 31, 2025

Equipment Needed

- **Uniform Pants:**
 - **BASEBALL** – Grey pants for T-Ball, Coach Pitch, Minors and Juniors.
 - **SOFTBALL**-Black pants for all levels.
- **Helmet and glove**

- **Bats:** All Softball and Baseball levels (excluding Baseball Juniors) need a USA BASEBALL approved bat (must have logo on bat). For Baseball Juniors a BBCOR approved bat.
- Baseball cleats are recommended.

Divisions

Tee Ball (Baseball Ages 4-6 years old): Focus will be on FUN and skills development. Children will hit from a batting tee and have coaches pitch to them by the end of the season. The children will learn the basics of hitting, catching, throwing, and game concepts. We also hope to develop parents as future managers, coaches, and volunteers from this level. No scores are kept!

Coach Pitch (Baseball and Softball Ages 6-8 years old): Skills development continues at this level. The fundamentals of position play will be learned, and skills will be enhanced to include base running and reaction to game situations. Score is kept but team standings are not.

Minors (Baseball Ages 7-10; Softball Ages 8-10): Skills development at this level. Kids will pitch from regulation distance and will learn more fundamentals to base running and stealing bases. The teams are based on evaluations by the managers of the teams at this level and select board members. These divisions are Little League divisions – all kids in this bracket are eligible for District play on our All Star Teams.

Majors (Baseball Ages 9-10; Softball ages 10-12): Emphasis at this level is on teamwork and continuing to learn the more advanced rules of baseball and softball. The teams are based on evaluations by the managers of the teams at this level. These divisions are Little League divisions – all kids in this bracket are eligible for District play on our All Star Teams.

Juniors (Baseball Ages 13-14; Softball ages 12-14): Emphasis on this level is on teamwork and continuing to learn the more advanced rules of baseball and softball. This level is also designed to help develop the players to be ready for playing at the high school level. These divisions are Little League divisions – all kids in this bracket are eligible for District play on our All Star Teams.
